

Fellow's Guideline for the Transplant-Infectious Disease Conference 2009-20010

Time and Location of the Transplant-Infectious Disease Conference:

The Transplant-ID Conference takes place every other month beginning September, 2009. It is scheduled for the third Tuesday of the month from 12:30 PM to 1:30 PM. It will take place in the professional building conference room unless otherwise specified. Fellow's attendance is mandatory.

Fellow's Responsibility:

The assigned renal fellow will work in collaboration with the assigned ID fellow to present a case followed by relevant discussions related to the topic. The presentation should be prepared using PowerPoint format. The renal/ID fellow each has a 50/50 equal responsibility in preparing for the conference.

Cases:

The renal fellow and the ID fellow will preferably select an actual case for the conference. However, if there is no actual case available, then they will choose a case from published literature for discussion or present a didactic teaching session. Examples of good topics include CMV, TB, Parvo virus, BK virus, Aspergillus, Hepatitis B/C, Coccidioides, Cryptococcus, West Nile virus, Toxoplasmosis, multi-drug resistant bacteria such as VRE/MRSA, etc.

Projector:

The ID division will be responsible for bringing the projector to the conference.

Food:

The Transplant division will be responsible for setting up food for the conference.
